ADMISSION DEADLINE AND REQUIREMENTS:

Now is an ideal time for advanced study in political science at the University of Utah:

- The Department has added six new faculty members in the last three years covering every area of political science

Students with a Master's degree from the University of Utah work at all levels of government and hold leadership positions in non-profits, non-governmental organizations, and in the private sector.

Our PhD students hold positions at the University of Texas (Dallas), Colorado State, Boise State, University of Portland, Texas Tech, Northern Arizona University, Weber State University, Drake University, Lake Forest College, Zayed University, and Abu Dhabi.

The application deadline is January 15th for admission into the graduate program for Fall Semester.

Requirements:

- An undergraduate GPA of at least 3.2, based on all undergraduate work. If the undergraduate GPA is below 3.2, a GPA will be calculated on the last 60 semester hours (90 quarter hours) of the undergraduate work for admission consideration.
- A bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university.
- GRE Score (within the past five years)
- Application approved by the department Graduate Studies Committee.
